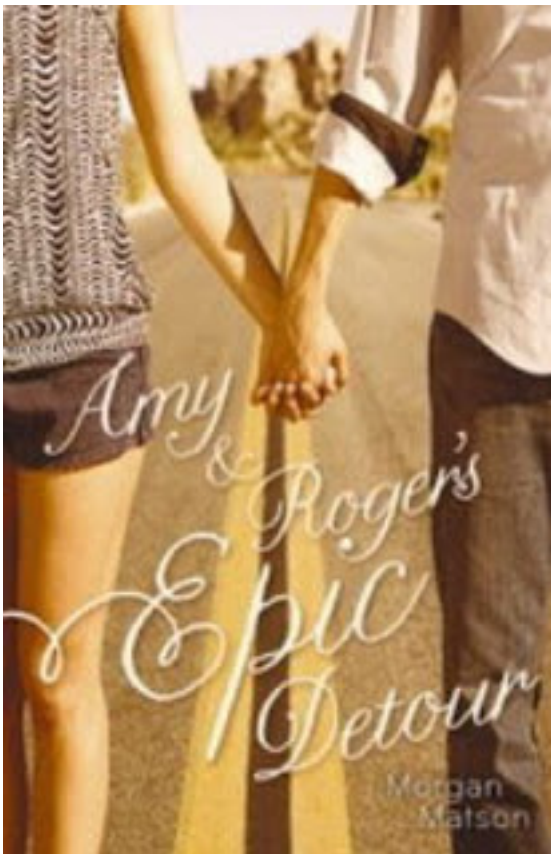


Review of Amy and Roger's Epic Detour by Morgan Matson
